congregation (effective Sunday, December 31, 2017).**

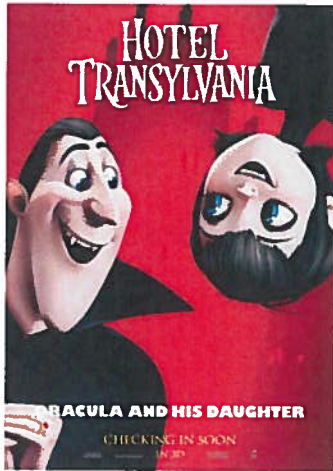
To do so, I need the permission of the congregation. It is the congregation who called me to this work in January, 2010. It is the congregation who can now release me from the covenant between us.

Movie on the Lawn:

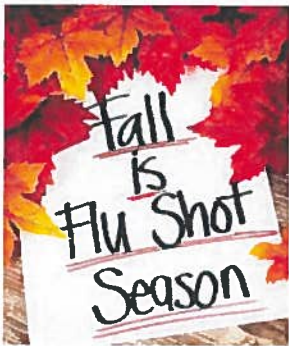
